Total Credit Requirement

In order to complete the Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Nail Services, the learner is essentially required to gain a minimum of 48 Credits. Of which, 24 credits must be the mandatory units, and the other 24 credits (minimum) will be further optional. However, this programme has been structured with 51 Credits in total, composing 24 credits of the mandatory units and 27 credits of the optional units as provided below. The Guided learning hours (GLH) are 384 hours, 190 hours of the mandatory units and other 194 hours of the optional units.

Compulsory Non-Credit Modules (Additional)

There are two non-credit modules added in addition to the required units. The first module is information regarding COVID-19 infection prevention. Another module is anatomy and physiology. These two modules are theoretically taught, plus some practical sessions, with an aim to prepare the learners for the external assessment papers. The accumulated hour of learning these two compulsory non-credit modules must be 64 hours spent in this programme.

Teaching Methods

All units and modules are delivered two-day blocks (Monday and Tuesday) every week. This is intensive and allows all learners to immerse themselves in a topic thoroughly. These are great for flexibility around work, location, and other commitments learners may have. For teaching days, all learners will need to be at the TAITAM-D Academy for a practical training. There will be an online based learning for theoretical sessions. However, due to the current COVID-19 situation, the institute has restrictions and regulations to follow with for preventing them and our teaching staff from predictable incidences like Corona virus-infected illness that can obscurely spread around in our environment and from person to person. There are three different types of teaching - theoretical lecture, practice, and self-practice.

Assessment

To complete this qualification, all learners must show that their achievements meet the mandatory requirements, which are assessed and evaluated by centre assessors, related persons, or parties - the internal quality assurance and the external quality assurance. The evidence to prove that the learner's outcomes are satisfying is a broad range of forms, ranging from an observed work record, a witness statement, an audio-visual media, written questions, assignments, case studies, and the physical proof of passed external exam. Each unit and module have different assessments needed to be taken. Herein, information on what and how many assessments are required is provided in the table below.
